

The Noguchi Museum is dedicated to the work of Isamu Noguchi (1904–1988), one of the twentieth century’s most important and critically acclaimed artists. Through a lifetime of creative experimentation, Noguchi created sculpture in stone, wood, metal, and clay, as well as gardens, furniture, and lighting designs. He collaborated with architects on public projects and choreographers on set designs.

The Noguchi Museum – an intimate, reflective space with a tranquil sculpture garden at its heart – is itself one of the artist’s greatest works. Opened to the public in 1985 in a former photo-engraving plant in Long Island City, New York, the Museum presents a comprehensive collection of Noguchi’s art. In the spirit of Noguchi’s broad artistic outlook and on the occasion of the renovation of its 1929 building, the Museum has implemented its first program of temporary exhibitions, focusing on different aspects of Noguchi’s work. These include the work not only of Isamu Noguchi, but also of other artists and designers, thereby illuminating both the context in which Noguchi’s work was created and his long legacy of innovation and artistic exploration.

The Museum offers a variety of education and public programs that seek to introduce the work and vision of Isamu Noguchi to a diverse audience. These programs encourage the investigation of the ideas presented at the Museum from different vantage points, supporting participants as they experience the work from their own perspective. The Museum presents lectures, symposia, workshops, tours, and other events related to the work of Isamu Noguchi, the Museum’s permanent collection, and temporary exhibitions. Free educator-led tours are available to Museum visitors daily. Private tours for adult and student groups are available by appointment.
