


Final Design: Reflective Bench Crystallized Reflection Concept

#### **DESIGN**



Three identical slots beneath the bench allow a single mirror to be placed and moved. As visitors interact with the piece—repositioning the mirror to explore new reflections—they uncover unexpected perspectives through movement, time, and quiet attention.





This sculptural bench reveals a mirrored underside that reflects a hidden, shifting world—shaped by light, seasons, and surrounding forms.



## Goal I - Aesthetic Alignment


Echoes Noguchi's language through organic forms and mirrored surfaces that interact with light, shadow, and space.
